Dear Sir,

We are in receipt of an inquiry for the following men of whom we enclose what information we can. There was no enquirer's name given, but we presume that we are correct in replying to your office, as there have been previous inquiries from there for some of these men:

100' No. 2007. Pte. A. D. Brunby, 25th Battn. A.I.F. He is still officially reported "Missing" as from 29.7.16. Nothing further has come ~~to~~ to hand up to the present.

No. 2278. Pte. E.C. Seabrook, 52nd Battn. A.I.F. This man is still reported "Missing from 4.9.16" by Head Quarters. We previously forwarded you what unofficial information we had gleaned from other men who knew him. Since then nothing further has come to hand.

No. 4623. Pte. W.W. Campbell, 12th Battn. A.I.F. Head Quarters ^{21st} confirmed the report that this man is "Missing 19th-20th.8.16." Unfortunately we have received, up to the present, no later news from our searchers.
